Commissioned by Shoalhaven Waste Rangers Unit in 2016, The Eaton Gorge Theatre Company have developed this 45 minute show suitable for years 4 to 6 that looks at litter and illegal dumping, and the impact of wildlife specific to the Shoalhaven area.

With a great influx of visitors to the area over the holiday periods, litter and dumping have become a major issue for the local local Environment. Many local species are becoming threatened including the Golden Bell Frog, The Ground Parrot and the Eastern Pygmy Possum. The show stars a kangaroo and a ranger and with help from a number of puppets they provide plenty of facts and interactive opportunities for the children to be involved in solving the issues of illegal dumping and litter.
